This act states that providers may receive supplemental reimbursements for emergency medical transportation in addition to the amount they traditionally receive for Medicaid ground emergency medical transportation. The act specifies the characteristics the providers must meet to receive the supplemental reimbursement for the reporting period. The act explains how the reimbursement amount will be determined and how it will be distributed. It specifies what governmental entities must do if they want to receive the supplemental reimbursement on behalf of a provider. Participation is voluntary. The act also allows the Department of Social Services to design and implement an intergovernmental transfer program for ground emergency medical transportation so that capitation payments can be increased and the provider reimbursement increased. It sets the requirements providers must meet to obtain the increased reimbursement. MO HealthNet managed care plans and coordinated care organizations will pay 100% of any increased capitation payments. The intergovernmental transfer program will be implemented on the date federal approval is obtained. Participation is voluntary.
