



Is Your Teen Interested In Summer Employment?

If your teen is interested in summer employment the Summer Teen Employment Program (STEP) may be your answer.

STEP is offered through EasterSeals Midwest and provides a six-week summer employment training opportunity for high school teens who are returning to school in the fall. The teens work 20 hours per week at local community businesses in small groups of students with a job coach and are paid minimum wage.



The purpose of the program is to provide work experience for teens to learn the difference between school and work, determine what types of jobs they like and dislike and identify their work skills, abilities, and needs. Participants and their families get a first-hand experience in working with supported employment agencies and an opportunity to see the possibilities of what competitive employment might look like for them in the future.
