Emergency Weather Response Hotline for St. Charles, Lincoln and Warren Counties

From December through March, if temperatures are predicted to be 20 degrees or below overnight (via weather.com), the Continuum of Care will activate a Free Warming Center Response to provide safe sleeping accommodations for the night.
