Among other provisions, this act states that all MO HealthNet recipients will be covered for dental

podiatry, optometric, hospice care, therapy, and comprehensive day rehabilitation services. The act also states that orthopedic and prosthetic devices will be covered for all recipients. Physical, occupational, and speech therapy are covered as long as they are prescribed, medically necessary services. The act states that a web-based prior authorization system will be developed to verify the medical need for therapy. This act requires the Department of Social Services to seek any waivers necessary to allow MO HealthNet to promote better and healthier health behaviors with all recipients including preventative care and tobacco use limitations and to allow health plans to offer health savings accounts.

Beginning January 1, 2015, after being determined eligible all MO HealthNet recipients including those on spenddown will have a continuous twelve months of eligibility.

The act requires those MO HealthNet recipients who might be eligible for health insurance through the health insurance exchange to be notified by the Department and told what benefits would potentially be covered under the insurance.

This act requires all insurers offering MO HealthNet insurance plans to also offer the plans in the private insurance market. Any insurer who fails to do so will have its MO HealthNet contract sanctioned or cancelled.

The act requires the Dept. to ensure that managed care plans maintain adequate provider networks. It outlines, at a minimum, what should be included in a managed care network. The act requires managed care organizations to notify the Dept. of changes to their provider networks in a timely manner and that listings of provider networks be posted on managed care websites and updated on a monthly basis. Any provider not accepting new patients should be noted as such in the postings.

Secret surveys will be conducted to ensure that managed care organizations comply with network adequacy standards set forth by the Dept. The

Dept. will contract with an independent organization to conduct the surveys.

The act outlines what may cause managed care organizations to be sanctioned. It outlines what should be included when managed care plans provide out-of-network access.

It requires the Dept. to set up a competitive bidding process for managed care contracts, outlines what should be included in bid proposals, and how the process should operate.

Individuals enrolling in managed care plans will be able to choose their plan. It outlines what all MO HealthNet plans will include.

It outlines the data that must be supplied to the Dept. by managed care organizations.

The act discusses implementation of health care homes for those who are deemed to be "medically frail."

The act defines "medically frail" and states that beginning January 1, 2015 those individuals will receive all benefits they are eligible to receive. A screening process will be developed to determine who is "medically frail."

Those individuals who are "medically frail" and who would benefit from a health care home will be enrolled in one by the Dept. Individuals who are eligible may opt out of the health home program.

The act requires the Dept. to request an enhanced funding rate for those who are newly eligible.

All recipients with chronic conditions will be included in an incentive program to involve primary and preventative care and refraining from certain activities so the recipients overall health is improved. The incentives may include cash payments. The Dept. will determine the rules of the program and implement the program.

The act requires the Dept. to submit a state plan amendment for approval to establish a Section 1915 (i) Home and Community-Based Services benefit to encourage the use of HCBS before meeting the level of skilled nursing care. It outlines what the state plan amendment may include. The age requirement will be eliminated for individuals who meet the permanent and total disabilities requirement pending federal approval.
