This act changes the definition the definition of "employer" to include an industry affecting commerce who has six or more employees for each working day in each of the twenty or more calendar weeks in a current or preceding calendar year. The act states that plaintiffs may be awarded actual and punitive damages and may award court costs and reasonable attorney fees to the prevailing party. It details the amount of the caps for punitive damages.

Modifies provisions relating to the Second Injury Fund

This act changes the definition of "employer." There are provisions for employer penalties. Compensation for permanent disability will be computed based on the earnings at the time of the last compensable injury. The act adds the one hundred fifty-fifth week level to the criteria for a subsequent compensable injury. If someone has received money previously from the second injury fund because of pre-existing disabilities and a compensable injury, the amount will be deducted from the remaining balance. The second injury fund will only pay permanent total disability benefits after the individual has reached maximum medical improvement and credit has been given for the time representing the employer's liability. The second injury fund pays the difference between the employer and the permanent total disability. It puts limits on when the second injury fund will pay for medical or burial expenses. An employee or dependent must file proof of service with the Division of Worker's Compensation within one hundred twenty days of filing a claim. The claim will be dismissed if this is not filed. The act also includes other provisions.
