ASSISTIVE TECHNOLOGY***HB 517 - Newman**

Adds an individual with mental disabilities to the list of people who must be afforded the same rights as those without disabilities in public places and the right to be accompanied by a service dog

This act adds those with mental disabilities including Autism to the individuals allowed to be accompanied by a service dog in public.
