ASSISTIVE TECHNOLOGY**HB 517 - Newman****Issue 6**

Adds an individual with mental disabilities to the list of people who must be afforded the same rights as those without disabilities in public places and the right to be accompanied by a service dog

Revises the definition of service dog to include animals that provide support or therapeutic functions for individuals with psychiatric or mental disabilities

This act changes the definition of a service dog to include "emotional support animal" and "psychiatric service dog." Emotional support animal is defined as an animal that provides therapeutic benefit to an owner through companionship and affection, but that is not specifically trained to ameliorate disability. Psychiatric service dog is defined as a dog individually trained to do work or perform tasks that mitigate the difficulties of its owner with a psychiatric disability. Definitions of "professional therapy dog," "search and rescue dog," and "service team dog" used in other bills are included in this bill.

The instructor is not required to be certified unless the instruction is designed to result in certification.
