This act states that if an individual has a disability or is at least age sixty-five, owns a principal residence and for 2014 has a federal adjusted gross income under \$72,380 beginning in 2014, for property tax assessment purposes, the assessed valuation of a principal residence will not increase more than the percentage of increase of the individual's social security benefits for the previous year. Proof of disability will need to be provided to the county assessor.
