Funding Priorities:

Market Rate Adjustment (MRA) The DDRB intends to provide a MRA on existing contracts, if possible. More information will be provided no later than January 17, 2019.

Applications for growth will be accepted. Funding of growth requests will be dependent on availability of funds and level of priority, as defined below:

- 1. Critical for individual's/family's health and safety
 - Having the potential to become disastrous: at the point of crisis
 - Individuals life would be unstable and at risk of severe harm if service is not received
- 2. Essential to individual's/family's quality of life
 - Absolutely necessary, extremely important
 - Individual would not have the skills/supports to participate in key life areas: employment, mobility, independent living
 - Environment/community would not be able to support individual's participation: home, community services
- 3. Enhances individual's/family's quality of life
 - Beneficial for increased independence/interaction with others
 - Assists individual in social interaction to avoid social isolation

Agencies submitting growth requests are required to have a hearing with the Board.

Pilot Projects. If an agency has identified a new pilot project, and is interested in applying for funds for a pilot project, a letter of intent (including an impact statement) must be submitted by 4:00 p.m. on February 27, 2019. **Agencies submitting Pilot Project requests are required to meet with the Program Committee.**
