People have what they need to live the lives they choose.



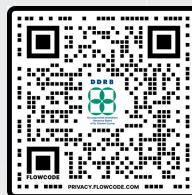
About Us

The DDRB is a public taxing entity, commonly known as a "Senate Bill 40 Board" that enters into funding contracts with agencies that serve individuals with developmental disabilities in St. Charles County. This public tax was established in 1977 when voters of St. Charles County approved to tax themselves up to sixteen cents per \$100,000 of assessed property valuation to provide community based programs and supports for citizens with developmental disabilities.

What We Do

The DDRB provides funding to agencies that serve individuals with developmental disabilities in St. Charles County. It also provides case management services to more than 1,300 individuals 16 and 17 years of age regardless of Medicaid status and individuals 18 years of age and older with active Medicaid.
